
Therefore, this fall, two Bible Study groups are offered. The group will choose the Book and we will study it together—chapter and verse. I will provide the background and "helpful hints".

July 2017 Budget Update (Combined General and Building Funds)


The chart below shows a simplified over view of our budget numbers for the six months of 2017.


The numbers through the end of May showed a combined deficit in the General and Building Funds of \$703 between budgeted expenses and actual offerings. The slight deficit was due to the fact that again in June actual offerings ran behind our budgeted expenses. So far for our two summer months we have been almost \$6,000 behind in actual offerings vs. budgeted expenses. So please remember if you've taken vacation this summer and missed one or more Sundays – make sure to put your offering in for those Sunday(s) when you return.

The child care program made it's shared expense payments of \$700 per week, which helped maintain a balance between overall cash receipts and cash disbursements.

Even with the shortfall we had again in June did not have to take anything from our building savings account to meet expenses.






